1. COLLEGE PROFILE

Tripura Medical College & Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital stepped to admit first batch of MBBS students in the year 2006 obtaining permission from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India. The Medical Council of India recommended to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India to grant recognition to the Tripura Medical College & Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital and thereafter the Medical Council of India granted affiliations vide Memo. No.U.12012/126/2004-ME/PII dated 23 May 2011. Thereafter, Medical Council of India is continuing to grant renewal of 100 seats for UG students (MBBS) and last renewal was done on 03.07.2025. Tripura Medical College & Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital is permanently affiliated by the Tripura (Central) University, Agartala. The goal of the Institution is to create responsive Institution to produce "Indian Medical Graduate" "IGM" possessing requisite knowledge in medical field, skill, attitude, ethics, value and responsiveness appropriately and effectively as Physician at the first contact of the community. Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital dedicatedly attached to the Tripura Medical College. The Class Rooms are fully equipped with modern equipments and air conditioned with adequate space and so as to Laboratories. All faculties, technical, non technical staff are devoted to the College and the Hospital to promote the College and Hospital to the national standard. Besides MBBS Course, the Medical Council of India has also recognized MD and MS Courses in Pharmacology, Pathology, ENT, Ophthalmology and General Medicine.

The college is attached to a full-fledged 490 bedded hospital having all necessary clinical departments including 24 hours Casualty/ Emergency services and well equipped special clinics.

2. ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR MBBS COURSE (2025-26)

Tripura Medical College & Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital is a Society run Medical College. All seats are to be filled up according to the merit list of NEET UG-2025 published by Director of Medical Education, Government of Tripura.

2.1. Method of selection:-

- a. Common Counseling will be conducted by a committee as constituted by the Government of Tripura, Health & Family Welfare Department.

- c. All candidates are advised to remain in touch with college website "www.tripuramedicalcollege.ac.in" and Director of Medical Education, Govt. of Tripura website "trmcc.admissions.nic.in" for latest information regarding counseling and admission.

2.2. Distribution of seats:-

Annual intake of the Tripura Medical College is 100 (one hundred) students per year as recognized by the NMC. Accordingly, total number of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26 will be 100 and the seat distribution will be as follows:

For admission of Tripura State Domicile candidates, Reservation will be followed as per Reservation Policy of the Govt. of Tripura and for All India candidate other than Tripura State Domicile candidates, Reservation Policy of Govt. of India will be followed. Category wise seat matrix will be notified by the office of the Director of Medical Education, Govt. of Tripura.

2.3. Eligibility Criteria:-

- A candidate must qualify the NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST (UG)-2025 and also meet all the criteria as mentioned in NEET INFORMATION BULLETEIN (SESSION 2025-26) and GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION REGULATION of Medical Council of India for admission in 1st year MBBS course for the academic year 2025-26.
- All admissions are subject to verification of the original certificates / documents produced by the candidates. Regarding the eligibility of any applicant, the decision of the Permanent Admission Committee constituted by the Medical College Authority as per the NMC guidelines shall be the final.
- All admissions are subject to medical fitness of the candidates. Admission will be denied to candidates if found medically unfit.

2.4. Documents (in Original) required during the time of admission:

- Age proof (Pass Certificate of the SSLC / Madhyamik Examination / Admit Card of Madhyamik Examination).
- Permanent Resident Certificate from the Competent Authority (in case of Tripura State Domicile)
- Aadhar Card/e-Aadhar card
- Admit Card of NEET UG-2025
- Mark sheet of NEET UG-2025
- Mark sheet of the (10+2) H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ST / SC / OBC/ Ward of ex-serviceman/ Person with disability (PwD) certificate from the Competent Authority (where applicable)
- Migration certificate (where applicable)
- A Character certificate from School/Institution last attended by the candidate has to be submitted either on the day of admission or within two weeks from the date of admission.
- A notarized Affidavit in a non-judicial stamp paper has to be submitted by the candidate declaring a statement against Racism on the day of admission (format is attached at page-19 of the Information Brochure cum Prospectus for MBBS course: 2025)
- A notarized Affidavit in a non-judicial stamp paper has to be submitted by the candidate and his/her parents/guardians declaring a statement against Sexual Harassment on the day

of admission (Format is attached at page-20 and 21 of the Information Brochure cum Prospectus for MBBS course: 2025)

- l. A notarized Affidavit in a non-judicial stamp paper has to be submitted in the shape of Bond for discontinuation of course within three days after admission (format is attached at Annexure-A of the Information Brochure cum Prospectus for MBBS course: 2025)
- m. 3 (three) Colored recent (after 01-01-2025) Passport size photo of the candidate with date and name of the candidate.

Note: - After admission, the above mentioned documents in original will be kept under the custody of Tripura Medical College & Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital throughout the MBBS course including one year Compulsory Rotating Medical Internship (CRMI) Training of the candidate. Once admitted, the original documents will not be handed over to the candidate in any circumstances until the stipulated time period as mentioned above is completed.

2. Fees for Admission to MBBS Course

Tuition Fee is payable as detailed below which has been fixed 3(three) years back as per recommendation of the Fee Structure Committee constituted by the Govt. of Tripura as per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India: -

3.1 NOTE:

- **Regarding tuition fees of MBBS course:**
Tuition fee shall have to be paid at a time at the time of admission and by 31st August every year. Late fee would be Rs.200/- per day if paid after stipulated time and date and should not be extended beyond 30(thirty) days
- **Stay in College Hostel during Rotating Compulsory Internship is must and interns shall have to pay Rs. 2000/- per month as rent. If they take food from hostel mess, they have to pay mess charges as would be applicable and shall follow Rules and regulations of the Mess. The Mess Manager will be selected by the boarders of the Hostel after discussion.**
- **Mess charge includes cost of breakfast, lunch and dinner. The mess charge will be kept in a separate bank account which will be jointly operated by GM (HR) and Chairman of Hostel Mess committee after discussion with Mess Manager to be selected from students.**
- **In case a student decides to withdraw and leave the Institution within the period allowed for counseling, 5% of total amount of fees for 1st year course will be recovered and the remaining amount will be refunded.**
- **UG Discontinuation Bond to be executed by a Candidate to pay an amount of Rs. 20.00 Lakhs to the Institute if he/she discontinues the course before completion of his /her MBBS (UG) Course as per notification of the Secretary, Health, Government of Tripura vide no. F.11 (31)-DME/UG/PG BOND/2016/8019-50 dated 13th December, 2019.**
- **In case a student is retained beyond 4 ½ years for whatever the reason may be, he/she shall have to pay forthwith the fees as proportionately applicable for the additional duration.**
- **A Bond/ Undertaking shall have to be furnished by selected candidate at the time of admission in respect of institutional discipline, payment of annual fees, College uniform including Blazer, ragging, no damage properties of institution etc.**

3.2 Method of payment:

4. GENERAL ACADEMIC INFORMATION

4.1 Duration of course: - 4 ½ (four and half) years and one year period of Compulsory Rotating Medical Internship Training after passing of 3rd Professional Part-II MBBS (Final Examination) and Competency Based Medical Education (CBME) will be followed. The commencement of academic session for the First year MBBS course, attendance of classes of students for whole course and other related matters of MBBS course will be followed as per guidelines of NMC.

4.2 Institutional Discipline :-

This is an Institution meant for higher learning and the objective is not only to impart class room teaching learning experience but also to build the character of the students and transform them into better human beings and responsible citizens of the country. All students shall have to stay in the hostel and abide by Rules and Regulations laid down in the Hostel Rules, Tripura Medical College Hostel Rules, 2016. Students shall have to observe absolute discipline in their conduct during the entire period in the Institution. In case of their failure to observe absolute discipline, disciplinary action would be followed:-

- i. Ragging in any form is prohibited.
 - ii. All students shall be well dressed, well behaved & well mannered. They shall have to be polite, considerate to their fellow students, teachers, management and staff members of the College
 - iii. During college hours, all students shall wear a white full sleeved apron/blazer over their cloths throughout the course.
 - iv. Use of mobile phones inside classrooms and carrying mobile phones in examination halls by the students is strictly prohibited.
 - v. Consumption of alcohol, narcotics, smoking or any kind of intoxicants is strictly prohibited in the College & Hospital campus.
 - vi. Any break of discipline or failure to carry out the orders of the Principal/Competent Authority shall be dealt strictly which may result even expulsion from the college and filing of FIR with the police.
 - vii. The Rules and Regulations as prescribed and displayed in the Hospital should strictly be followed.
- X. Institutional Dress code (formal) has to be maintained mandatorily.

5. SAY, NO TO RAGGING

5.1 What is ragging :-

Ragging means any conduct whether by words, spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating, threatening or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of cause or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

5.2 Awardable punishment for ragging:-

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Withholding / Withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
3. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
4. Withholding results.
5. Debarring from representing the Institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc
6. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
7. Cancellation of admission.
8. Rustication from the Institution for a period ragging from 1 to 4 semesters.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
10. Fine of Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 1,00,000/-
11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
12. Criminal Prosecution.

Please Note:-

Ragging in any form is a punishable offence as per MCI Regulations, 2009 and is strictly prohibited. Every guardian along with the candidate has to submit an undertaking in this regard at the time of admission that their word shall not be involved in ragging in any form. If anyone is found to be involved in ragging, he / she will be punished on recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Committee of Tripura Medical College constituted for that purpose.

- Abetment to ragging,

- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging, Public nuisance created during ragging,
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging, Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt,
- Wrongful confinement, Use of criminal force,
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences, Extortion,
- Criminal trespass,
- Offences against property, Criminal intimidation,
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s), Physical or psychological humiliation,
- All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging".
